PRAYER FOR OPEN DOORS

Colossians 4:2-6 NIV

"Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone."

Ephesians 6:18-20 NIV

"And pray in the Spirit with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people. Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should."

Reflection

I love Paul's passion for prayer. You can feel it spilling over as he writes. Just as these words were an inspiration to the believers in the early church, they are an inspiration to us now to live a prayer filled life. As we read these scriptures I believe that God is encouraging us to remain steadfast in prayer.

When writing to the church in Ephesus Paul also gives us a key to enable us to pray for any situation or circumstance that we may find ourselves in. He directs us to "pray in the spirit". A Greek word that is used to describe the Holy Spirit is "Paracletos", which means "one called alongside to help".

Today, the Holy Spirit stands with us, right beside us, ready to help us to pray. If we are honest there are many times when don't have the words to pray, or feel tired and weary as we come to prayer. The great thing is that there is never a occasion when we stand alone in prayer. The Holy Spirit is alongside us to strengthen us, to lead us, and to inspire us in prayer. We just have to lean into Him, and ask Him to help us.

Over the last few weeks, I have heard so many testimonies of how people's lives have been transformed by meeting Jesus. Consistently in every conversion story was the combination prayer and witness. Paul points to the fact that prayer empowered His witness. We see that prayer opens doors for us to share, enables us to speak with clarity, and to make the most of every opportunity. Can I encourage you this month to pray for open doors to share Jesus with those around, and, when these opportunities appear, that we would be fearless, clear and full of grace as we testify to who Jesus is and what He has done.
